Bathroom specialist Clearwater has collaborated with the artist Emily Forgot to create a one-of-a-kind hand-painted artwork on the exterior of its 'Asher' engineered stone freestanding bath. Emily, whose multidisciplinary practice in London encompasses art, design and illustration, has based her abstract 'Apricity' motif on colour studies of the seasons in her signature geometric style.
